

Using enVisionMATH Online at Home



Go to your web browser — such as Internet Explorer , Firefox, or Safari and type in the **enVisionMATH** home page at <https://www.pearsonsuccessnet.com/>. For future reference save this address as a “favorite” or “bookmark” in your browser.

When you first visit the website, click on the link: [Check your computer's settings](#)

This is located on the right side of the home page and will let you know what updates you may need on your computer to run all of the activities on the site.

Common Updates:

- **Download Adobe Flash and Adobe Shockwave plug-ins.**
- **Download QuickTime**
- **Disable pop-up blockers or configure the pop-up blocker to include pearsonsuccessnet.com**
- **Enable JavaScript™ and cookies.**
- **Disable the Internet Explorer® Content Advisor.**

Now you are ready to log-in!

Type in your child's very own username and password given to you by your child's teacher on the Parent Letter that was sent home. Then click **Log In**. You are now logged in and can click on **Open Book** to navigate through the math book online, or **To Do** in order to see what your teacher has assigned. Enjoy!
