

New Student Enrollment Information

- ★ New students desiring to enroll at Goddard High School should first contact the School Counseling Office at (316) 794-4115.
- ★ A parent or legal guardian will need to make an appointment to meet with his/her student and a Counselor to initiate the enrollment process.
- ★ Parent(s) or the legal guardian(s) of the student are required to live within the boundaries of the Goddard School District in order for the student to attend GHS.

What you will need to bring to complete enrollment:

- ♦ The name, address, and phone number of the last school attended.
- ♦ The name of the Guidance Counselor or other school contact person from the last school attended.
- ♦ An up-to-date transcript of all previously completed high school course work.
- ♦ A copy of your high school class schedule indicating the classes you were taking at the time you left your previous school.
- ♦ Exit grades from any high school courses that were in progress when you left your previous school.
- ♦ Immunization records.
- ♦ Documentation of guardianship (if applicable).
- ♦ A current copy of the Individualized Education Plan (IEP) – (only for students receiving special education services).

Additional Information:

- ♦ Lunch cards and deposits (payments) made into a student's lunch account are handled through the main office.
- ♦ Locker assignments appear on schedules available at Open House and the first day of school.
- ♦ Bus transportation arrangements are part of the initial enrollment process.
- ♦ The normal school schedule is from 7:40 a.m. to 2:44 p.m.

- ♦ Goddard High School operates on a seven hour day schedule with 5 minute breaks between classes. All students are required to have a full schedule with classes scheduled for every period – there are no study halls.

- ♦ All absences from school need to be reported before 9:30 a.m. the same day of the absence. Absences are reported to the school attendance office at 794-4100.
