

INTRAMURAL BASKETBALL 2010 SEASON

The Goddard Schools offer an intramural basketball program open to all **4th through 6th grade students** and **7th & 8th grade students who are not on their school's basketball team**. The Intramural program is focused on teaching basic basketball skills, sportsmanship, and teamwork. It is not a competitive program.

The Intramural basketball program will begin on **Saturday, January 9, 2010**. Please read over the following information with your child. All basketball players must have their permission form signed and returned by **Wednesday, January 6, 2010!**

Please return the signed permission form to your PE teacher, homeroom teacher or to the office of the school your child attends.

FORMAT:

Each session will begin with a focus on a particular basketball skill. Goddard High School basketball players will teach and model these weekly skills. Participants will be given an opportunity to practice each skill. At the end of each session the students will scrimmage against each other. Some of the skills to be covered include: rules of basketball, ball handling, defense, shooting, rebounding, and passing.

WHEN:

Sessions will begin on **Saturday, January 9, 2010**, and will be played **January 16, 23, 30** and **February 6, 13, 20**. In the event of inclement weather, listen to local news media for cancellation.

Boys play @ the **Challenger / Discovery** building North Gym

TIME:

Intramurals will run on Saturday mornings starting at 8:00 A.M. Gym doors open at 7:45.

The following schedule may change depending on the number of kids that sign up in each grade. If adjustments are necessary, we will inform you at the first session and they will take effect the second session.

4th graders play from 8:00 - 9:00 am

5th graders play from 9:00 - 10:00 am

6th, 7th & 8th graders play from 10:00- 11:00 am

DRESS:

Gym shoes are required. T-shirts, shorts/sweats are recommended.

COACHES:

Goddard High School students will be teaching and coaching the players this year under the supervision of the intramural sponsors.

COST:

There is **NO COST** for this program.

PARENTS:

You are welcome to be at each of your child's sessions and watch his/her skills improve. If you don't stay for your child's session, you will need to pick them up when the session is over.

NOTE:

Restrooms will be open, but locker rooms and hallways will be off limits. If you bring small children to intramurals, please ensure that they stay in the gym. They should be supervised at all times and are not permitted to run around in the school. Our program is designed for learning, fun, and the enjoyment of all.
