Types of Foster Families

- Family Resource Care – for children who may be placed in your home for a few days or several months until they are able to return home or another permanent placement is arranged.
- Emergency Foster Care – for children who need to be taken out of their home immediately. Their stay in emergency foster care will not exceed 72 business hours.
- Respite Foster Care - for a child who is living with another resource family and will stay with you for an evening or weekend.
- Diversion and Specialized Diversion Foster Care –highly trained resource families for children who may need intensive therapy and/or medication.
