### **Items that need to be done by parents and teachers:**

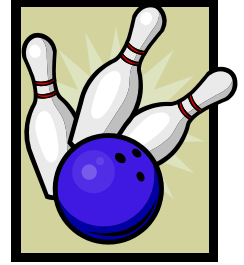
